## MEMBERS – PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING POINTS.

- Please note that due to safety or other circumstances shoots may need to be cancelled, changed or moved to another date. Any changes to the program will be communicated by email distribution or Facebook as soon as changes have been determined. So that you are not disadvantaged can you please ensure:
  - The club has your current home and email addresses.*
  - That you check your email and Facebook before coming to the range, especially if the weather is inclement.*
- Rifle bolts are not to be inserted into a Firearm unless on the firing line. Empty chamber indicators (ECI's) are available from the club and are the preferred option for indicating a firearm is safe when not on the firing line.
- If you shoot at another Club and wish to have that attendance counted towards your mandatory attendance, **it is your responsibility** under the legislation to provide evidence of that shoot to the Club Secretary.
- This program is subject to change. Members need to monitor the Facebook page and their emails as any changes are published there, including whether or not the range will be closed.
- Note that while the club will still operate a dual program (morning and afternoon), spare sessions have been added. This **a.** provides the committee with less work and more rest, and **b.** can be used to add sessions including those requested by members. However, requested sessions will require a minimum of 8 members – Two range officers and 6 competitors.
- Unless stated otherwise, morning shoots are 9am sign-in, 9:30 shoot and afternoon shoots are 12md sign-in and 12:30pm shoot.**

**Shooting Disciplines/Events Notes (to apply unless advised prior to shoot)**

1. FClass/Sporter shoots are two (2) details of 2 convertible sighters, with 10 shots to count
2. **Anzac Memorial shoot** – Including Harry Hall and Wal Cameron Memorial Trophies. 300metres x 1 application, 1 snap and 1 double snap on a type B target. Optional front sand bags available for service rifles only, no specialised coats or gloves. **Classes:** A. 303 as issued B. 303 or genuine issued service rifle with any iron or optical sight (set to 6 power) and 3. 5.56mm (.223) Class – 69gr projectiles (6 x scope power), 223 rifles to be shot off hand. **Note:** At the conclusion of the Anzac matches the Long Tan shoot will be conducted using 223 and 308 rifles. Final format to be advised prior to the shoot.
3. **Rimfire Fly;** from the benches - 2 stages – 2 targets per stage, unlimited sighters, 5 for a group in each stage with a time limit of 12minutes per stage, warning at 10minutes.
4. **Field Class.** Removed from the program due to lack of participation. A field class event can be run on request from members but would require 2 Range Officers and 6 competitors as a minimum (total of 8 members).

**REMINDER TO CLUB MEMBERS**

1. Under the firearms regulations all club members are required to attend a minimum of **4** shoots per year to maintain their shooters licence. The club is required to submit an annual return to the Firearms Registry of those shooters who **have not** complied with these regulations. This attendance period ends on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026
2. **Members completing shoots at other ranges should notify the secretary so that these can be recorded as range attendances.**
3. Annual Tamworth and Peel Valley Club membership fees are due by the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026 A schedule of fees and reminder will be emailed to all members.
4. If you have an email address, could you please make sure the club has a copy so that you can receive club correspondence every week.
5. If you have changed your name or address you need to notify the Club as per the Firearms Regulations.
